AFSCME ENDORSES McCAMLEY

Latest Endorsement a Sign of Building Momentum

LAS CRUCES – Today Congressional candidate and Doña Ana County Commissioner Bill McCamley announced that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) had endorsed his candidacy for US Congress in New Mexico’s Second Congressional District.

AFSCME represents over 12,000 city, county, state, and university employees in New Mexico.

AFSCME New Mexico’s Political Action Committee voted to endorse McCamley, citing his “great relationship with labor over the years.”

“I am thrilled to receive AFSCME’s support,” said McCamley. “This endorsement shows that our message is getting through and our momentum is growing.”

McCamley is a Doña Ana County Commissioner and was Executive Director of the New Mexico Rural Development Council.

McCamley recently won the Democratic Party’s Pre-Primary Convention for the Second Congressional District 49% over his remaining opponent Harry Teague’s 36% in a tremendous show of strength. He has previously been endorsed by the New Mexico Building and Construction Trades Council, which represents over 7,000 New Mexico workers. He has also received endorsements from numerous current and former elected Democratic officials in the Second District.

Since declaring his candidacy in April, McCamley has put over 50,000 miles on his car, traveling to every county in the district to listen to the concerns of constituents. He has raised \$350,000.
