## **McCAMELEY REPORTS OVER \$212,000 IN THE BANK FOR PRIMARY RACE**

*\$265,000 Raised So Far From Over 560 Contributors*

(Las Cruces, NM) – Doña Ana County Commissioner and Second District Congressional candidate Bill McCamley will report having over \$212,000 in the bank at the end of 2007, almost all of it available for spending in the primary. Since declaring his candidacy in April, McCamley has raised \$265,000 from over 560 contributors.

“We are grateful for the large number of supporters who have contributed to our campaign. It really shows how so many people out there believe in our message of commitment, results, and change,” said McCamley. “Of course, this election is about more than money,” said McCamley. “It is about who can deliver the real change we so desperately need in Washington. In every county I’ve visited, the response to our campaign has been tremendous.”

Since declaring his candidacy in April, McCamley has visited all 18 counties in the Second District, meeting with citizens and putting over 40,000 miles on his car in the process.

McCamley has received endorsements from eight elected Democratic officials in the Second District: Public Regulation Commissioner Sandy Jones, State Representatives Antonio Lujan (Doña Ana County), Andy Nuñez (Doña Ana County), and Nate Cote (Doña Ana and Otero Counties), Doña Ana County Commissioner Dolores Saldaña-Caviness, Eddy County Commissioner Tony Hernandez, and Carlsbad City Councilmen Manny Anaya and Jeff Diamond. He has also been endorsed by the New Mexico Building and Construction Trades Council, which represents over 7,000 New Mexico workers.
