## **BILL McCAMLEY RELEASES STATEMENT ON PEARCE DECLARING CANDIDACY FOR SENATE**

### *McCamley Reaffirms Commitment to Win and Bring Change to Washington*

(Las Cruces, NM) – Today congressional candidate and Doña Ana County Commissioner Bill McCamley released the following statement on Steve Pearce’s Senate candidacy and the Second District Congressional Race:

“When I announced my candidacy for this seat back in early April, I did so because I wanted to bring a focus on getting results for the people of southern New Mexico. I truly believed that Steve Pearce had failed to represent the people of the Second District, and I stood up to take on the challenge of beating him. Since I announced my candidacy, I have put over 30,000 miles on my car traveling the 2<sup>nd</sup> district to meet with the people of southern New Mexico and hear about their concerns and issues.

“Now that Pearce has announced his candidacy for Senate, I am more committed than ever to winning this seat and using it to bring real change to Washington. With over \$200,000 raised so far and the recent endorsements of key elected officials and unions, our campaign is picking up momentum, and we are going to keep gaining momentum all the way to victory next November.”

McCamley has received endorsements from four key Democratic elected officials in New Mexico’s 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District: Representatives Antonio Lujan (Doña Ana County), Andy Nuñez (Doña Ana County), and Nate Cote (Doña Ana and Otero Counties), and District 5 Public Regulation Commissioner Sandy Jones. He also has been endorsed by the New Mexico Building & Construction Trades Council, which represents over 7,000 workers in New Mexico.

McCamley announced his candidacy in early April of this year.
