McCAMELY CHALLENGES TEAGUE TO DEBATES

Hands Teague Letter Seeking “four one-on-one candidate forums throughout the Second District”

LAS CRUCES – Yesterday at a forum in Silver City Congressional candidate and Doña Ana County Commissioner Bill McCamley presented his opponent Harry Teague with a letter asking Teague to join him for “four one-on-one candidate forums through the Second District—one during each week in May.” (To read the full text of the letter, please see attached.)

The letter noted that “[i]f democracy really is about representing the people, then we owe the voters the chance to talk with us together in an in-depth format about their issues and concerns.”

McCamley asked that Teague have someone on his staff get in touch with McCamley’s staff about setting up the four forums.

McCamley is a Doña Ana County Commissioner and was Executive Director of the New Mexico Rural Development Council.

McCamley recently won the Democratic Party’s Pre-Primary Convention for the Second Congressional District, taking 49% of the delegates to Teague’s 36% in a tremendous show of strength. He has been endorsed by the New Mexico Building and Construction Trades Council, which represents over 7,000 New Mexico workers, and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), which represents over 12,000 workers in New Mexico. He has also received endorsements from numerous current and former elected Democratic officials in the Second District.

Since declaring his candidacy in April, McCamley has put over 50,000 miles on his car – enough to circle the earth twice – traveling to every county in the district to listen to the concerns of constituents. He has raised over \$350,000.
