ROSWELL, LAS CRUCES, SILVER CITY NEWSPAPERS ENDORSE McCAMLEY

McCamley Message of Fixing Washington for the Middle Class Resonating in Counties Across the District

LAS CRUCES – Today Congressional candidate and Doña Ana County Commissioner Bill McCamley announced that he had received the endorsements of three key newspapers from across the Second Congressional District: *The Las Cruces Sun-News*, *The Roswell Daily Record*, and *The Silver City Daily Press*.

In its endorsement, the *Sun-News* editorial said the board has been “impressed with his work as a Doña Ana County Commissioner. He has shown an ability to bring disparate groups together...” The editorial also called McCamley “forward-thinking with energy...and the economy.”

The *Daily Press* said that “McCamley is committed to taking a different approach to representing southern New Mexico. We feel he represents real change. Why not try electing someone who’s not a rich oilman from the eastern part of the state for a change.” It also called McCamley “a strong campaigner with what we feel is a greater potential to beat a Republican in the general election.”

The *Daily Record* described McCamley’s “infectious enthusiasm and hopefulness for the future of our country” and how he “can talk intelligently about government operations and domestic and foreign policy. His outspoken manner might ruffle some feathers on Capitol Hill, but he backs up his passion with sound principles weighted with intelligent insights.” The *Record* concluded its endorsement by noting that “a hard-charging idealist with the smarts to back up his objectives and the unflagging energy of youth seems to be the best candidate for the job. We need a lawmaker who will not get lost in the shuffle and will inspire those around him with his fervor.”

“I am very grateful that newspapers in such diverse parts of the District have all endorsed my candidacy,” said McCamley. “They recognize that this election is about who the best candidate is to bring change to Washington, and I’m pleased they believe that I am that candidate.”

Within the last month, McCamley has been endorsed by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), the Sierra Club, and Al Kissling, the 2006 Democratic nominee for the District. McCamley was previously endorsed by the New Mexico Building and Construction Trades Council.
