McCAMELY RAISES \$140,000 IN FIRST QUARTER OF FUNDRAISING

STRONG START SHOWS McCAMELY OUT OF THE GATES QUICKLY

(Las Cruces, NM) – July 9, 2007. Democratic Congressional Candidate Bill McCamley reported that he had raised \$139,600 in the quarter that closed on June 30, his first quarter of fundraising.

“The money this campaign has raised in less than one quarter demonstrates that there is a hunger for change in our representation in Washington,” said McCamley.

In addition to his fundraising total, McCamley also announced that campaign expenditures for the quarter totaled just \$6,300, leaving him \$133,300 cash on hand.

“The money we’ve put in the bank this quarter is a key first step toward having the resources necessary to get out our message. We know that we’ve got a long way to go, but we’re off to a good start and we’ve shown that we will run a professional and extremely efficient campaign.”

The McCamley campaign’s contributions came from 216 different donors. The first quarter fundraising total is far higher and far earlier than any recent Democrat running in the second district. Among Democratic congressional candidates raising money on ActBlue, McCamley was one of the top fundraisers for the quarter.

McCamley, who declared his candidacy on April 4th, is a Doña Ana County Commissioner and a recent Executive Director of the New Mexico Rural Economic Development Response Council.
